During college, Don met his wife, Joanne, who also was involved in Crusade. Joanne had also grown up with godly parents and had a passion to impact the world for Christ. Don and Joanne were married in 1989. After college, they moved to Indianapolis and began attending Faith Missionary Church. Don worked in business sales and took seminary courses from Trinity Evangelical Divinity School through its extension program. Eventually the family, which now included three sons, Nathan, Zack and Tim, moved to Illinois to finish Don's Masters of Divinity at Trinity. During this time, Don and Joanne began the process of heading to Ukraine as missionaries. However, God clearly redirected them and confirmed that their long-term call was to pastoral ministry with a passion for missions.

For the last seven years, Don has served as a pastor at Faith Church, initially as Pastor of Student Ministry and currently as Pastor of Ministry Development. Throughout his time at Faith Church, Don has further developed his teaching and preaching skills; served as an elder through a variety of challenging circumstances; developed, refined and led the church's ministries; and ministered with other experienced pastors who have mentored and challenged him. At various times as he grew older and understood the Gospel more fully, he reaffirmed his decision to trust in Jesus Christ. In college at the University of Cincinnati - in an environment vastly different from his Christian roots - Don learned even more about the power of the gospel to transform lives. He joined Campus Crusade for Christ, and was trained in evangelism, discipleship, and leadership. He honed his ministry skills by leading discipleship groups, attending a summer-long leadership training project, leading short-term mission trips, and serving as a student leader.
